**PORTUGAL IS CALLING.
FOR YOU. FOR EVERYONE.**

On days of “very high” or “maximum” rural fire risk,

IT IS PROHIBITED TO:

- Smoke or light any type of fire in rural areas or on roads bordering or crossing them.
- Carry out fumigation or pest control activities in apiaries involving the use of fire.
- Launch sky lanterns or set off any type of firework rockets. Other pyrotechnic articles require authorisation from the local authority. Please check in advance.

Avoid fines.

WHEN WALKING OR PICNICKING IN RURAL AREAS:

- Bring prepared food that does not need reheating.
- Take a rubbish bag and dispose of waste in appropriate bins.
- Do not light any type of fire or bonfire.
- Portable stoves or barbecues may only be used in authorised areas, outside days classified as “very high” or “maximum” fire risk, and outside Priority Areas for Prevention and Safety*.
- Do not smoke.

DURING LOCAL FESTIVITIES:

- Do not set off firework rockets.
- Do not launch sky lanterns.
- Do not light any type of fire or bonfire.

Contact local authorities if you see any suspicious activity.

Check the daily rural fire risk index for your municipality and plan your forestry, agricultural and leisure activities accordingly.

IN CASE OF FIRE, CALL 112:

- Provide precise directions to the location.
- Keep access routes clear to allow emergency vehicles to pass.
- Respect road closures.
- Remain vigilant.
